

Meet Searcy. We are a genuine and comfy city who has set a national example for our small business revolution and community fusion – proof that together, much can be done.




HOW SEARCY IS PERCIEVED

Life here is appreciated but consistently lacking. It should not be understated that people do like aspects of the town. Many people like the size itself, seeing it as more relaxed than a dense city, yet with enough assets to live comfortably. Many people see it as an ideal environment for raising a family.

The opinions are naturally quite broad, but even favorable comments seldom leave out a desire for improvement. Social tensions have a sustained, ever-present quality to them, such as Harding University's imposition on the city culture, and byproducts of class disparity. Many people who have families wish there were more children's activities. Adolescents share common narratives of restless driving, where fun frequently means hanging out at Sonic or Wal-Mart. Adults invoke an absent nightlife – that word specifically, repeatedly.

HARDING UNIVERSITY

Searcy is generally known as a college town, owing to the sprawling campus of Harding University that sits across 350 acres and draws students from across the country, as well as internationally. Harding also boasts several other establishments across the town, such as the Harding Place retirement home.



WHITE COUNTY FAIR

The White County Fair, since 1935, has been an annual event that draws Searcy locals as well as Harding students. It includes rides, food, livestock shows, and more.

THE RIALTO

The Rialto Theater is a historic movie theater at Race and Spring Streets in central Searcy, Arkansas. Built in the 1920s and renovated in 1940, it is one of the few buildings in all of White County to exhibit Art Deco styling, and the only theater with that styling.

WILD SWEET WILLIAMS

Wild Sweet William's is a walk-in pastry bar, offering hand-made scones, kolaches, focaccia, babka, cookies, and muffins (sold by the piece or by the dozen). All batches are made fresh daily; store closes when sold out.

MIDNIGHT OIL COFFEE HOUSE

Midnight Oil, locally known as MO is a Kibo outpost proudly located in Searcy, AR, serving specialty coffee, lunch and homemade baked goods.




